

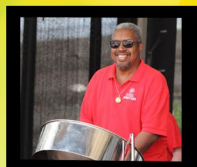

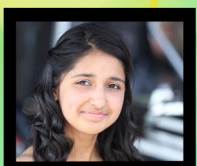

Popular local Steel Band who will bring the sounds of the Caribbean to the Promenade



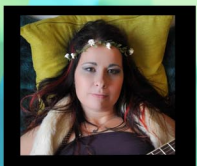

Emerging Gravesham talent who will be performing some classic hits from the charts



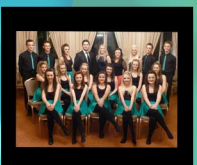
1.10PM YING TANG CHINESE ASSOCIATION
